

Alabama Tandem Weekend

April 18 – 20, 2008

A low key introduction to the season
Ride Chief Ladiga Trail
Anniston, Alabama to Cedartown, Georgia

The plan:

Meet Friday, April 18 in Anniston, Alabama. Friday ride your choice of a longer (50ish) mile ride or a short 30ish mile ride along rural Alabama roads. Check into the Victoria Inn and relax by the pool. Meet other teams prior to joining the group for an optional dinner at The Classic on Noble Street. Saturday enjoy your country breakfast and shuttle your car to Anniston's Tucker Park. Unload your bike, load your gear into the sag vehicle and prepare to ride the Chief Ladiga Trail (<http://www.chiefladiga.com/>) to Cedartown, Georgia. The group spends the night at the Holiday Inn Express in Cedartown, Georgia and returns to Anniston on Sunday.
